Introduction

Aegis Therapies has used rehabilitation outcome measures on all patients since the inception of the company. These rehabilitation outcome measures focus on the main functional areas that a patient requires to perform activities of daily living. These outcome measures are specific to each discipline and are rated on a 6 point scale from 0 – complete dependence to 3 – complete independence. These rehabilitation outcome measures also correlate with Medicare functional limitation measures.

Explanation of Results

The graph below shows a starting rehabilitation outcome score in the darker shade and a discharge rehabilitation outcome score in the lighter shade in the bar graph. The score is a combination of all outcome scores across all therapy disciplines involved with the patient. Patient's receiving therapy at Missouri Slope Lutheran Care Center on average are at a Modified Independence level upon discharge. Definitions – Avg LOS – is the average length of duration that the patient received therapy services. %Comm – is the percentage of patient's who returned to the community. Cases – is the number of patient's treated in the look back period for that particular diagnosis.
